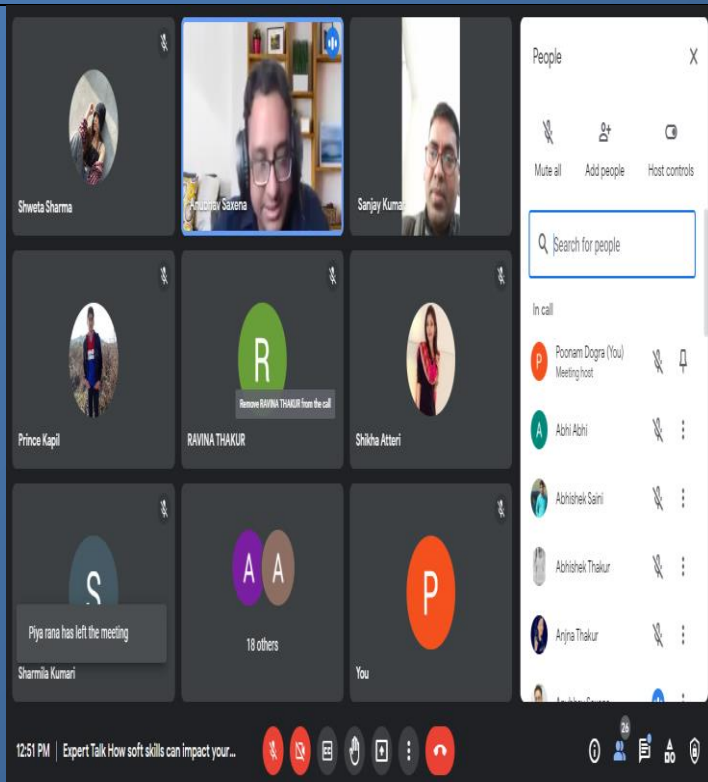
Organized Janaushadhi Mitra Conference in Pharmacy Department of Career Point University

Career Point University Himachal Pradesh Signed MoU with Indian Agricultural Research-Indian Institute of Pasture and Fodder Research, Jhansi

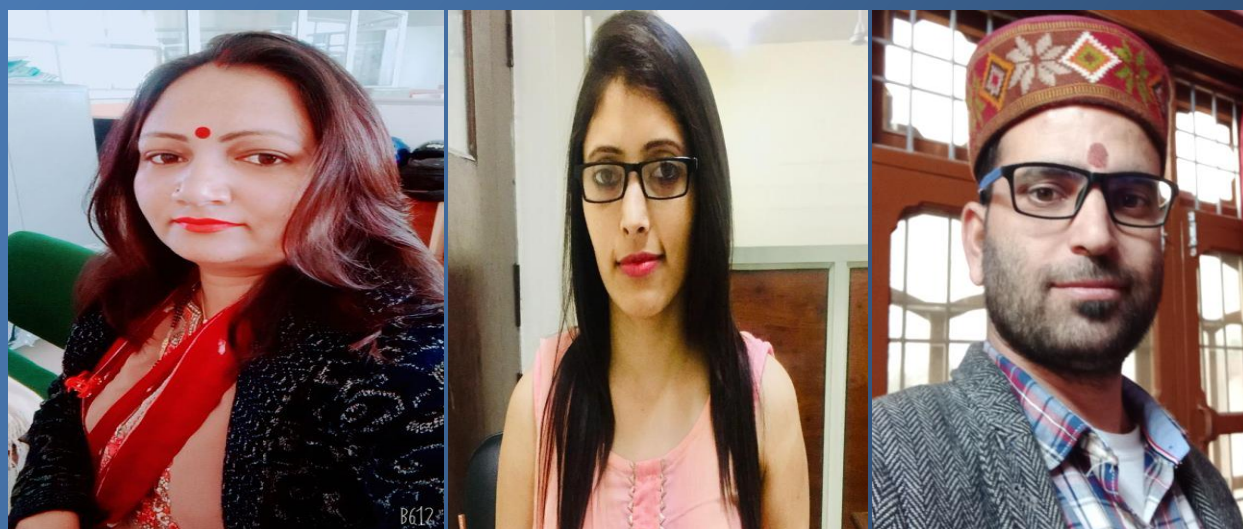
Agreement on Research on Improved Nutritional Quality Fodder in the Grasslands and Pastures of Himachal Pradesh

On 26th Nov. 2021, Career Point University Himachal Pradesh has signed MoU with Indian Agricultural Research-Indian Institute of Pasture and Fodder Research, Jhansi. This MoU was signed between Prof. (Dr.) K. S. Verma, the Honorable Vice Chancellor of Career Point University and Dr. Amresh Chandra, Director, Indian Pasture and Fodder Research Institute, Jhansi. Under the MoU, the University Establishing a forage garden of more than 50 improved varieties of fodder. Dr. A K Roy National Project Coordinator is working in Jhansi. He himself planted the seeds of improved fodder seeds in the fodder garden, and informed the farmers about it. It can increase the production of milk. Prof. (Dr.) K. S. Verma, the Honorable Vice Chancellor, Career Point University said that there is a shortage of about 48 percent in the total available fodder from all the resources in Himachal Pradesh.
