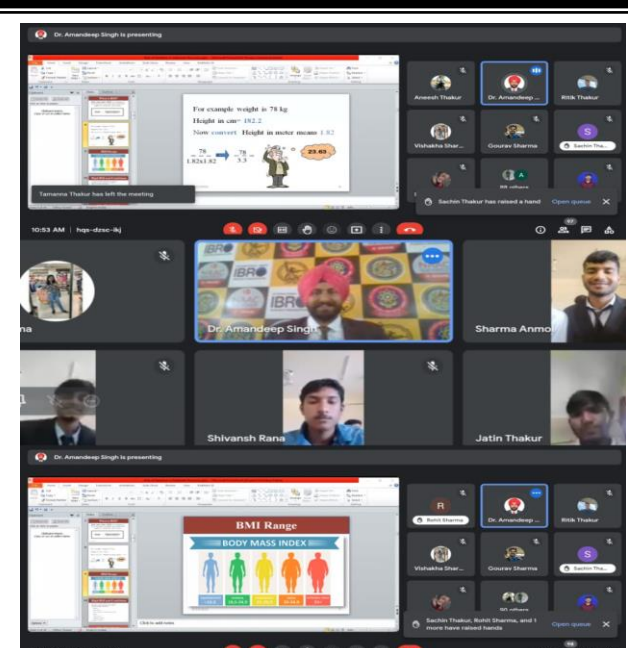

The suicide rate among people who use drugs is very high. Factors believed to be contributing to the increasing incidence of suicide include long-term use of alcohol and drugs that cause physical impairment of brain function as well as social isolation. Around 300 participants participated in this workshop. Coordinator of this workshop Dr. Anjana Devi, Assistant Professor Ankush Kumar and Vishakha thanked the experts and everyone present in the workshop.
