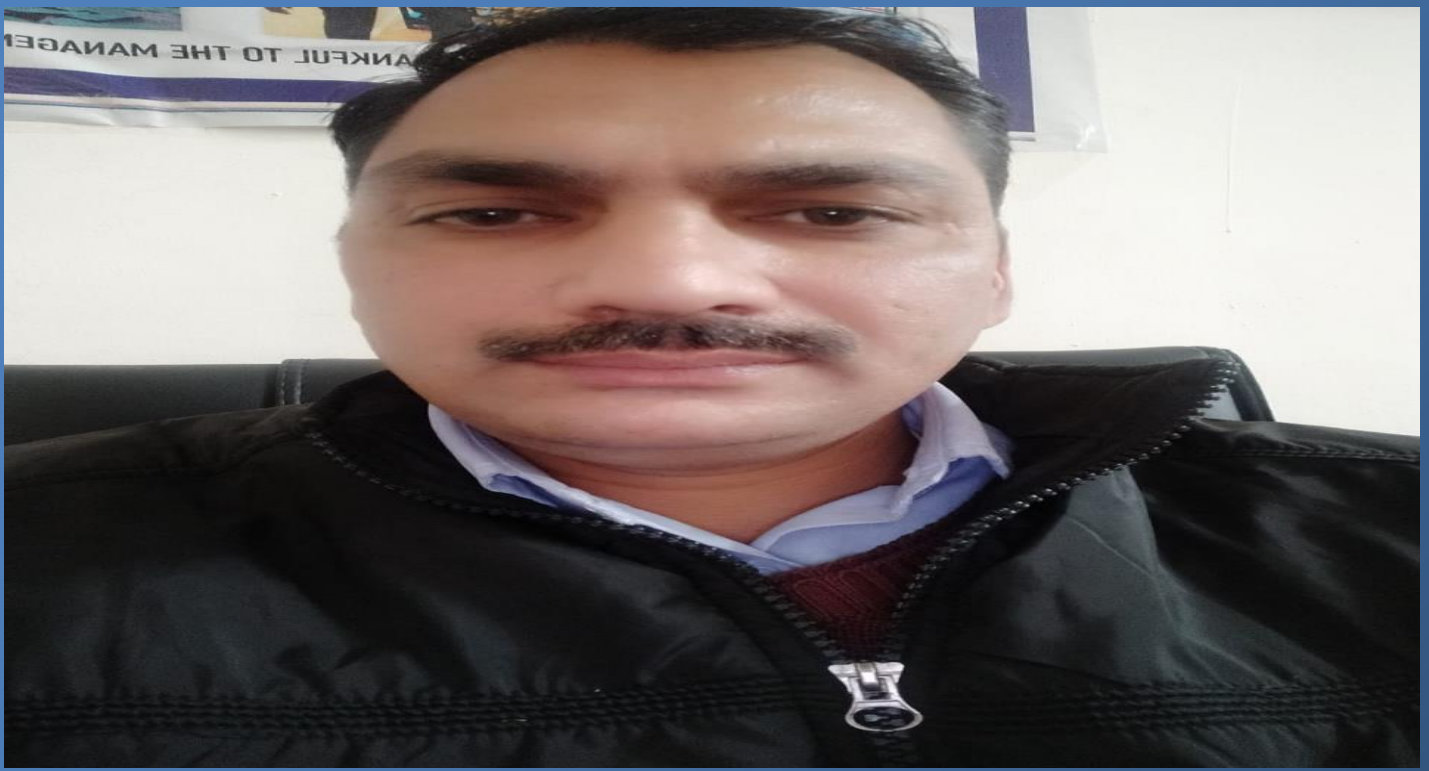
Students of Career Point University Hamirpur got Seven Lakh Package in Byjus Company

Farmers have also been given training for this. So that the farmer brother can earn his livelihood by cultivating Dhingri. To strengthen the economic condition. Because its crop starts yielding within 30 to 35 days. Wheat straw, paddy straw, dry leaves of maize and pulses are used for growing Dhingri. All kinds of husks, soybean, peas and mustard residues and cotton hulls etc. are in its. Waste items can be used. Therefore in every corner of our country, farming can be done. Manure is not required to grow Dhingri simply and it can be grown in cheap thatched rooms or raw brick houses. Many such of Dhingri there are species which can be grown in summer and many such species which can be grown in winter. Dhingri produce can be easily dried in the sun and dried as required for using. Its production cycle is very short. Dhingri contains all the nutrients like mushrooms and is rich in vitamins, proteins and minerals. Due to the increasing knowledge of the nutritional quality and medicinal importance of the mushrooms found, its consumption and demand are increasing continuously. Career Point University Hamirpur also started cultivation of Dhingri which has done and now its cultivation is almost ready.

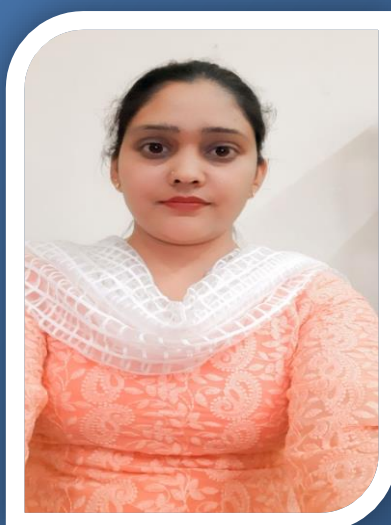
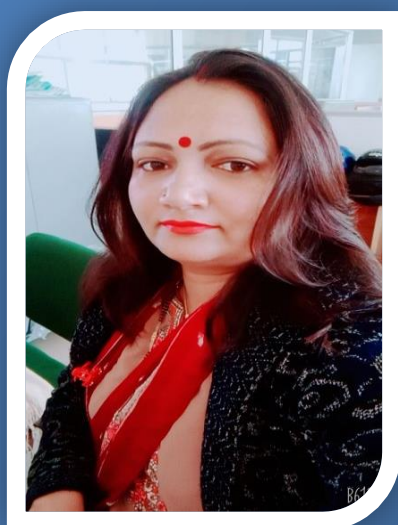
