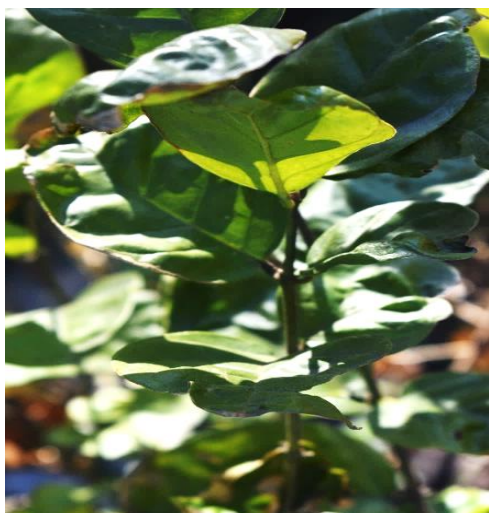


*Jasminum sambac* (L.) Aiton.

**Botanical Description:**

An evergreen climbing shrub, the stem is woody, hard, green when young, branches are flexible, leaves are simple, green, base round, ovate to elliptic, opposite, flowers are fragrant, pedicellate, bracteate, white in color, may be single or three-flowered in terminal cyme, and fruit is a berry, black when ripe.

**Flowering/ Fruiting:** Whole year.

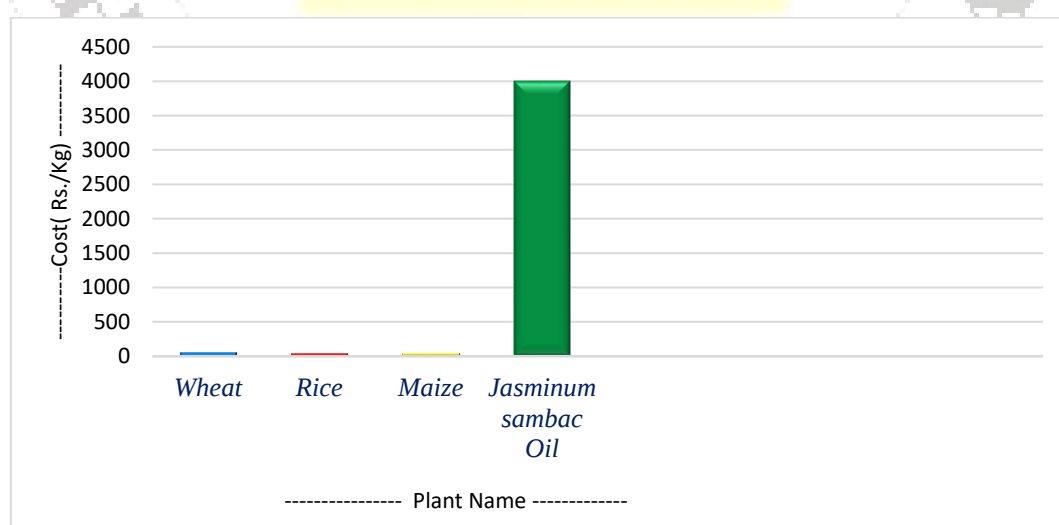
**Part Used:** Leaf, flowers, oil.
